## PERMISSION TO INTERVIEW, PHOTOGRAPH, VIDEOTAPE, OR TAPE RECORD

Dear Parent and Guardians:

Throughout the school year, opportunities arise to promote school and instructional activities at a particular school and/or throughout the District. Allowing access to students by news media or District staff for the purpose of interviewing, photographing, videotaping, or tape recording an identified activity are ways that the District works with individuals not associated with the District. Such instances may include but are not limited to the following:

- to record the history and events of the school by members of the staff for use at school assemblies, registration, or as part of an informational videotape about the school;
- to allow parents to videotape their child coming to school on the first day or participating in a class birthday party or similar event for home use; or
- to allow print media or electronic news media such as television and radio stations to cover important issues pertaining to the schools or school events of interest to the public for use on newspapers or news broadcasts.

In those instances, the purpose of the interview, videotaping, tape recording, or photography will be clearly identified as non-commercial.

Staff members are dedicated to providing all students with a safe, undisturbed school environment. At no time will they allow the use of video cameras or tape recorders to disrupt the educational program.

Your permission to interview, photograph, videotape, or audio tape your child is required. Please state your preference for videotaping your child or recording of your child's voice and have your child return this permission form to your child's school:
